

POSITION DESCRIPTION: Lighting Designer

HOURS: Estimated Minimum 30 hours/production

General Accountabilities

The lighting designer collaborates with the director to create the lighting for the production, and is responsible to the producer.

Specific Duties

- Collaborating with director on establishing a lighting design
- Collaborating with director, set and costume designers on a colour palette
- Creating a lighting plot
- Creating cue sheets
- Attending production meetings
- Attending rehearsals as needed
- Recommending and coordinating rental of additional lighting equipment as required
- Attending load-in, lighting hang, lighting focus, level set, tech and dress rehearsals, tear-down
- Working within a budget
- Attending a post-production meeting to review to discuss what went well and what could be improved, as input to a Post-Production Report coordinated by the Producer.
